

Electrically Heated Buildings in the Capital Region

New York City recently prohibited fossil-fuel heating in most new building construction starting in 2024. The rest of state is likely to adopt similar regulations in the coming weeks.

Right now, electrically-heated buildings is relatively uncommon in the Capital Region with several exceptions:

- Center Square Neighborhood, Albany
- Mansion Neighborhood, Albany
- Pinewood Manor, Albany
- Point of Woods, Albany
- Strawberry Ridge, Waterford
- Knox Woods, Halfmoon
- Mill Creek, East Greenbush

- Yellow and greens reflect a high percentage of homes heated with electricity.
- County/Town lines - TIGER/Line
