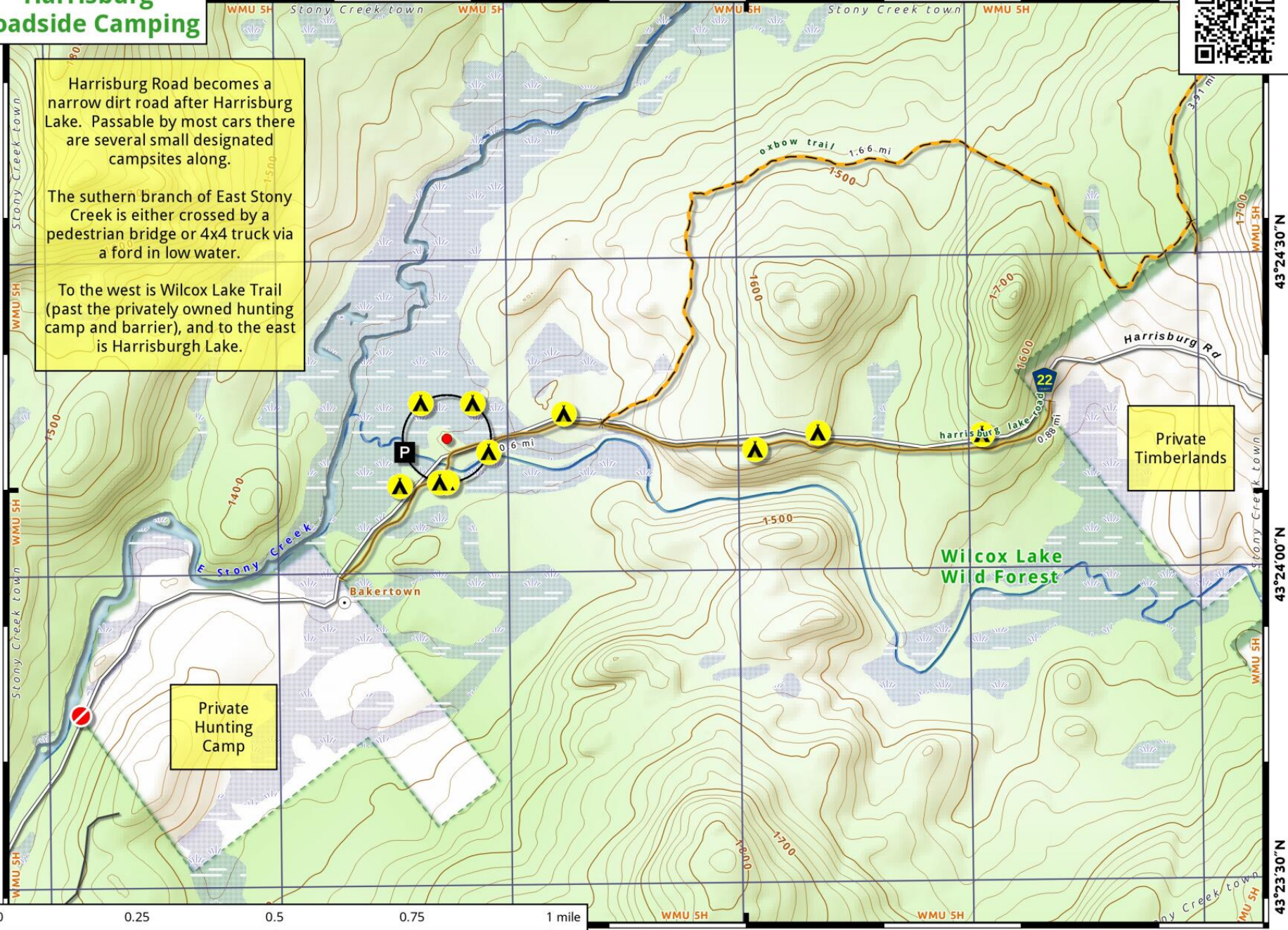


Harrisburg Road becomes a narrow dirt road after Harrisburg Lake. Passable by most cars there are several small designated campsites along.

The southern branch of East Stony Creek is either crossed by a pedestrian bridge or 4x4 truck via a ford in low water.

To the west is Wilcox Lake Trail (past the privately owned hunting camp and barrier), and to the east is Harrisburg Lake.
