



If you are looking for a quiet walk in the woods back to a nice lake, consider hiking the Wilcox Lake - Willis Lake Trail. A roughly 3 mile hike each direction from the inholding near the Doig Creek back to Wilcox Lake, the trail follows an old woods road up along the shoulder of the Pine Mountain, then after a 1/2 mile drops back into the valley following the Wilcox Lake Outlet, close enough to get some glimpses but not so close that it's muddy. A snowmobile bridge crosses Wilcox Lake Outlet, then the trail climbs the side of Wilcox Mountain and then drops back down to Wilcox Lake. Three designated campsites and lean-tos are at the lake.
