



Genegantslet State Forest is 3,201 acres sprawled along the ridge line to the east of the Genegantslet Creek in McDonough and Smithville. Consisting of a fairly narrow, sloped ridgeline, it provides access to portions of the Genegantslet Creek for trout fishing, several small ponds, a lean-to and roadside campsite.
