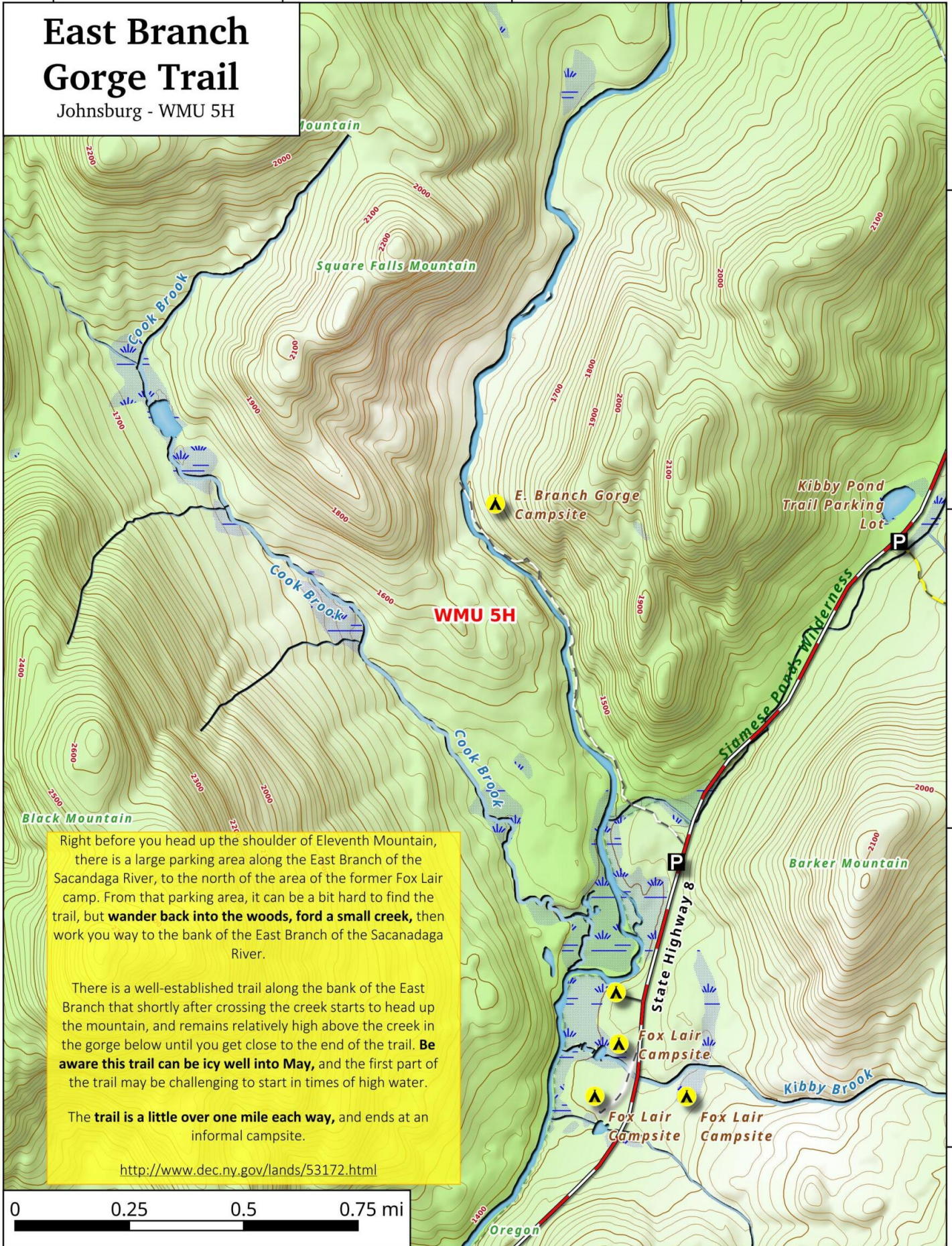

East Branch Gorge Trail

Johnsburg - WMU 5H

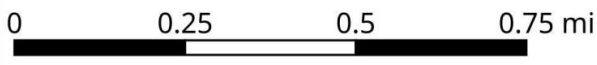


Right before you head up the shoulder of Eleventh Mountain, there is a large parking area along the East Branch of the Sacandaga River, to the north of the area of the former Fox Lair camp. From that parking area, it can be a bit hard to find the trail, but **wander back into the woods, ford a small creek**, then work your way to the bank of the East Branch of the Sacandaga River.

There is a well-established trail along the bank of the East Branch that shortly after crossing the creek starts to head up the mountain, and remains relatively high above the creek in the gorge below until you get close to the end of the trail. **Be aware this trail can be icy well into May**, and the first part of the trail may be challenging to start in times of high water.

The **trail is a little over one mile each way**, and ends at an informal campsite.
