

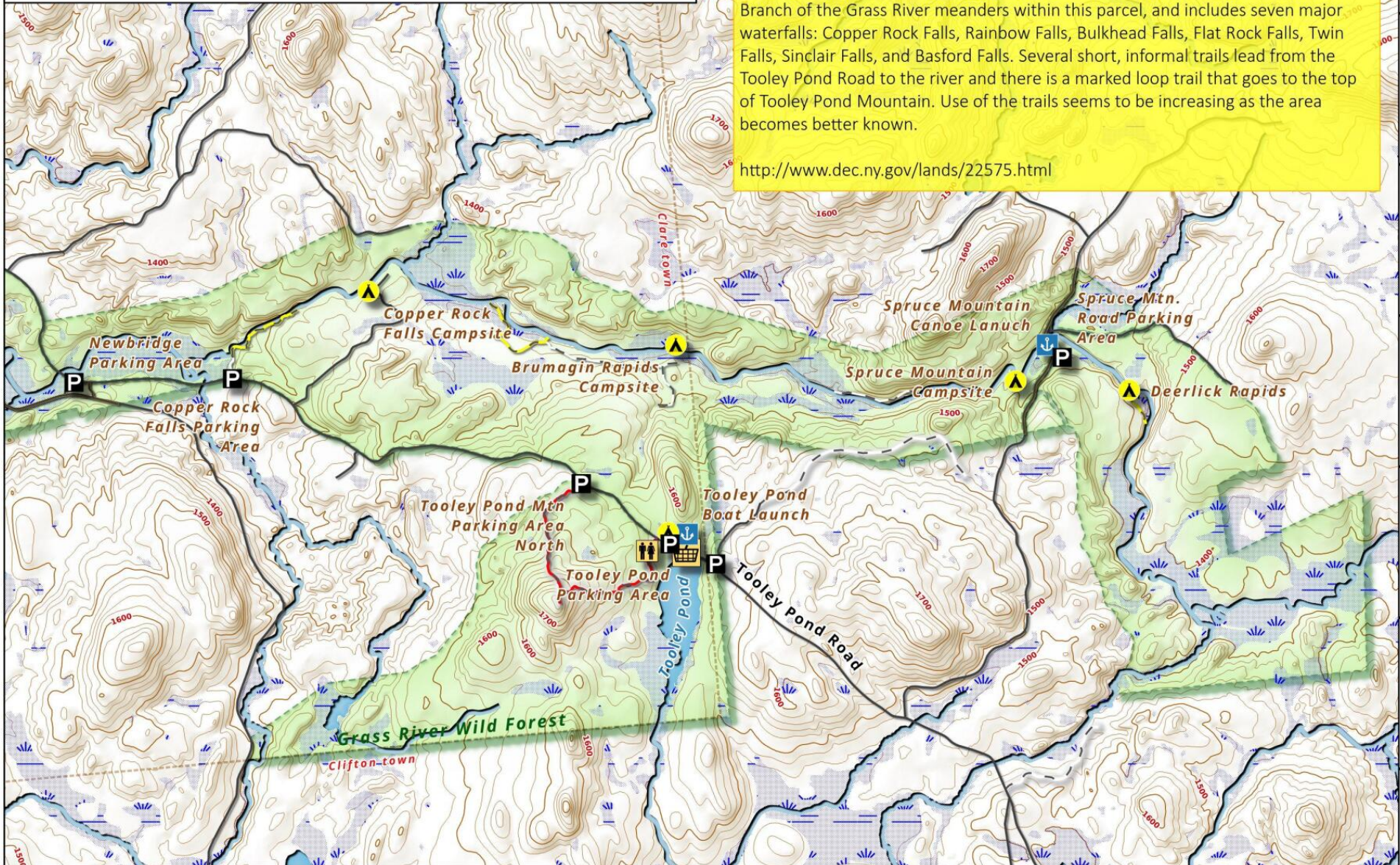
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Grass River - Tooley Pond Area

Clifton, Clare - WMU 6F

This six thousand acre parcel is basically a 1/2 to 1 mile wide strip of land along the South Branch of the Grass River. The Tooley Pond Road forms the boundary in three sections. The Tooley Pond CE is also adjacent. A sixteen mile section of the South Branch of the Grass River meanders within this parcel, and includes seven major waterfalls: Copper Rock Falls, Rainbow Falls, Bulkhead Falls, Flat Rock Falls, Twin Falls, Sinclair Falls, and Basford Falls. Several short, informal trails lead from the Tooley Pond Road to the river and there is a marked loop trail that goes to the top of Tooley Pond Mountain. Use of the trails seems to be increasing as the area becomes better known.

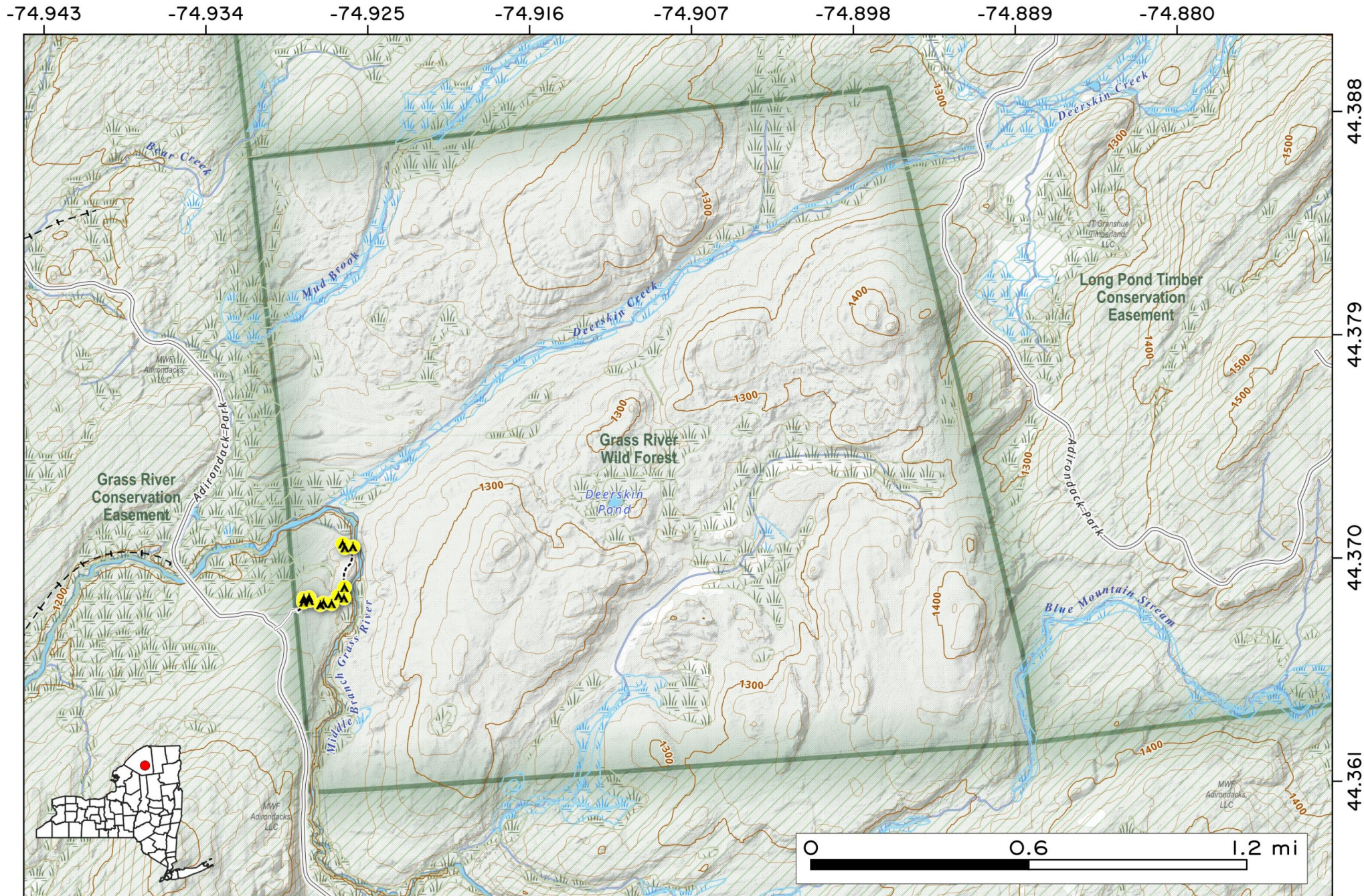

The **Tooley Pond Mountain Trail Loop** is an easy, two-mile, family-friendly hike in New York's Grass River Wild Forest. With gentle elevation gain (~239 ft), the well-marked trail meanders through a mixed forest to a partly wooded summit, offering views of distant peaks and historical fire tower remnants.
